NEW ADDITIONS

Leopard Ridger

On Wednesday the 20th of January 2021 Sonop Farms received the newest addition to our farm equipment being the Leopard Ridger. At Sonop our strategy is to stay ahead of the trends and the use of technology to increase efficiency.

The machine consists out of a big ripper, 300 litre fertilizer holders with two "fertisystems", ridge indicator, one on the left side and one on the right side and a curator applicator and weighs approximately 2.5ton. The machine is designed to make wider ridges for the tomatoes, to enable the planting of two rows, with enough space in-between and will be used in our open fields.
